Can any lock be fitted on my door?

This is typically not the case. The choice of lock will depend on the distance from the edge of the door to the center of the hole where the lock has to be set, and on the position of the hinges and the opening of the door. Other factors may be relevant as well.

How secure is a door lock with a knob?

These locks are convenient, but they are not the most secure. This is because if a thief gains access to the knob inside via a broken window or in another way, the door can be opened easily in seconds. Similarly, one intruder can open the door easily for others to come in.

What are anti-picking and anti-bumping locks?

These locks have cylinder mechanisms which cannot be picked and bumped. Picking and bumping are generally locksmith techniques, but they may be used by thieves for breaking into houses quietly without forced entry. The locks which are protected from these manipulations are among the most secure and recommended.

Is the brand important when selecting a door lock?

Yes, it is extremely important. The brand must be reputable and trustworthy above all. It is best if it uses the most advanced technologies and designs for its products. The keys which the locks of the manufacturer come with must be difficult to duplicate. Research the brand in advance.

What is a double-cylinder deadbolt lock?

This lock has two cylinders set in one line and facing each other. One cylinder is on the outside and the other is on the inside of the door. In this way, in order for the door to be opened from the inside, a key must be used. This lock is more secure than the traditional ones.

Should I consider commercial-grade locks for my house?

Most light commercial-grade locks can be installed on the common residential doors. They usually offer a higher level of protection compared to their traditional residential counterparts. However, they may not be that effective if they are not paired with a set of other higher-level security measures. You have to consider the cost as well.

What metal should the door lock be made of?

The metal must be strong and resistant to corrosion, scratching and denting. You should always consider the environmental conditions in the area when selecting a lock. You have to ensure that the model you invest in will be as weather-resistant as possible.

Are there maintenance-free locks?

All locks require very little basic maintenance. It is provided fairly rarely. Usually, you will have to attend to the locks no more than twice every year. It involves cleaning, lubrication and inspection. Not all people see maintenance as necessary, but it is actually important for the operation and the durability of locks.

How much should I spend on house door locks?

This is a matter of personal choice. You should consider how valuable the assets in your house are, the crime rate in the neighborhood and the other security measures which you have taken in order to assess the level of risk. You should also prepare a budget before you go shopping.

Should I consider door lock aesthetics as a shopper?

Looks are always important, but they should certainly be among the last factors to consider. You need to pay attention to the level of security which the locks offer and to their reliability and durability. Usually, the different models come in a variety of finishes to pick from so you will most likely not have to compromise on looks.

What are industry security standards?

These are standards which locks must meet in order to provide the required level of security. As part of the standardization system, the locks are graded in terms of the level of security which they provide. You should consider getting locks with the highest level of security which you can afford to buy.

Is a keyless lock a good choice for me?

These locks are operated with the use of a numerical keypad which has a small processor integrated in it. In order to open the door, you need to enter the code. Such locks are typically used in commercial settings, but they are suitable for residential use as well. The keypad must be protected from the elements.
